LOGSA manages critical logistics information around the globe and continues to focus on finding new capabilities to better support the Army's readiness requirements. The forum offers briefings and hands-on training classes focused on improving and sustaining Army readiness. This training provides Army logisticians an excellent opportunity to hone their skills and collaborate with other professional logisticians on a myriad of topics geared toward improving their organizations "Combat Readiness and Effectiveness."

The forum is designed to accommodate almost every learning style, whether you prefer large auditorium presentations, classroom, hands-on training, or one-on-one training provided by a subject matter expert. We invite you to get the most out of this forum by interacting with the instructors and your fellow attendees throughout the week and during our training social. Your participation and feedback will make the LLTF a success across the Army. Last year the LLTF supported 200 attendees. This year we are accommodating up to 250 people.
