### Course Description

The purpose of CASA training is to provide a broad understanding of the CASA software. The training will teach students how to generate cost analysis reports that cover total cost of system ownership and cover the entire lifecycle from its initial research cost through disposal. The class is divided into two sections. In the first 45 minutes we will discuss CASA and general Defense Acquisition Cost Analysis. The final part will be spent on a hands-on practical exercise. The practical exercise will take users step-by-step through the process of inserting data, importing files from other sources, printing, and reading reports from entered data. This course is typically 3 hours.

### Course Learning Objectives

At the end of the training, students will:

- Know what CASA is and how it is used
- Be familiar with Army Cost Analysis Comparison
- Be able to navigate through CASA
- Be able to enter data into CASA
- Know how to import different files into CASA
- Be able to run reports within CASA

### Materials

Instructors will provide computers and access to the CASA program. For training at our location in Huntsville, Alabama, the instructors will provide training manuals and handouts so students may follow along and take notes.

For off-site training, electronic copies of the training manual and handouts will be forwarded to the site point of contact so that they may provide copies for the students.
