

Systems Planning and Requirements Software (SYSPARS) Training Class Syllabus

Course Description

This course provides an overview of SYSPARS and how it assists the logistician in the Program Management document generation process. It also includes a hands-on portion where attendees can interact with the software and learn its capabilities. The class is concluded with a Practical Exercise that allows students to create their own document within SYSPARS. The course typically lasts 3 hours.

Course Learning Objectives

At the end of the training, students will:

- Know what SYSPARS is and how it is used
- Understand how SYSPARS can help the logistician
- Be able to navigate through SYSPARS
- Be able to run question reports within SYSPARS
- Be able to create any of the 18 documents within SYSPARS

Materials

Instructors will provide computers and access to the SYSPARS program. For training at our location in Huntsville, Alabama, the instructors will provide training manuals and handouts so students may follow along and take notes.

For off-site training, electronic copies of the training manual and handouts will be forwarded to the site point of contact so that they may provide copies for the students.
