## STORAGE PLANNING AND ANALYSIS

Established in 1948, the Packaging, Storage and Containerization Center (PSCC), an activity of the US Army Materiel Command Logistics Support Activity (LOGSA), has provided logistics support to the Warfighter for more than a half-century. LOGSA PSCC has a staff of globally recognized professionals that provide premiere distribution and testing solutions.

LOGSA PSCC's Distribution Facilities Specialists provide expert analysis of storage facilities, operational efficiencies, and evaluation of Materials Handling Equipment and storage aids. We provide on-site support in designing planographs and layouts for storage areas, calculating space requirements for new and/or existing supply operations, and preparing mandatory storage space reports. We also provide engineering consultant services for the modernization of distribution, storage, and materials handling operations within Army, DoD, and other Government agencies to include: designing storage; packaging; receiving and shipping operations layouts; developing/validating space requirements for supply operations; determining personnel, supplies, and publications requirements; determining equipment requirements to include preparing procurement documentation; and providing guidance to improve operational effectiveness.


Storage Space Management Report (SSMR) (DD Form 805) - Army installations with 50,000 or more gross square feet of covered storage space must, by regulation, file a SSMR. Accuracy of the report is essential since it is the only report within the DoD and Army which provides visibility of storage space utilization and is used to evaluate installations during BRAC reviews and by Congress to validate requests for construction of new storage facilities.

Our team of storage space experts is available for on-site visits to provide guidance to your personnel in completing the SSMR or, if needed, to complete an accurate report for your activity. We can also utilize Computer-Aided Design (CAD) technology to develop storage planographs depicting each of your storage areas, which will provide the data used to report the storage space.
