


Be Prepared with BMOG



Are you an E-5 or above, warrant officer, or commissioned officer O-1 through O-3, and up to your elbows in unit maintenance operations? If so, the battalion motor officer course (BMOG) is designed especially for you.

BMOG, course number 171 Q11, is only available through the Army Correspondence Course Program (ACCP). It comes in a CD-ROM format, contains 14 lessons and is divided into two parts.

Part one provides detailed instruction in ULLS-G, unit safety, environmental policies, tactical maintenance considerations, PMCS, scheduled maintenance, repair parts supply, administrative controls (licensing, dispatch, pubs), and AMSS reporting.

Part two is the PM checks that are part of daily motor pool operations.

Completion of both parts is required to receive course credit.
