


SUCK UP MOISTURE



Dear Editor,

The IFTE has a dehumidifier that sucks up moisture before it can hurt sensitive electronics.

Unfortunately, the IFTE storage van does not have a dehumidifier. And it's the storage van where replacement circuit cards and test sets are stored. Moisture can corrode and ruin circuit cards, some of which cost more than \$20,000.

So we recommend that IFTE units get a dehumidifier and use it in the storage van, especially if they're operating in very humid areas like Ft Polk or Ft Stewart. NSN 4440-00-566-0616 gets a dehumidifier for less than \$200, or you can probably find an even cheaper one locally. A few dollars spent now can save thousands later.
