CTIS SETTINGS KEEP YOU MOVING



If you're confused by the symbols used on the CTIS selector panel, you'll have a hard time driving your Stryker on different road conditions.

That means you may not get the traction you need to carry out the mission.

Setting 1:

This is the highway setting (81 psi).
Use this for fixed roads and highways.

Setting 2:

This is the cross country setting (47 psi) and
should be used for off-road conditions.



Setting 3:

This is the snow and mud setting (25 psi). Use it when
driving through snow and mud to gain added traction.

Setting 4:

The last is the emergency setting (18 psi),
which should be used when your Stryker is
stuck in deep mud, sand or snow.



Regardless of which setting you use, keep an eye on the low pressure and overspeed LEDs. They'll let you know if the air pressure is too low or if you're traveling too fast for the terrain setting you've selected.
