

# GIVE IT AN EASY RIDE


IF YOU'RE A **SOLDIER**, YOU'RE ON THE MOVE.

EACH SHEET IS 3-FT BY 3-FT AND AN INCH THICK.



TO FURTHER CUSHION THE TRIP, WRAP THE EQUIPMENT IN BUBBLE WRAP. NSN 8135-00-926-8991 BRINGS 250 FEET OF 2-FT WIDE AND 1/2-IN THICK WRAP.

ARE YOU SURE ALL THIS ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT WILL SURVIVE IN THE BACK OF THIS TRUCK? IT'S GONNA BE A ROUGH TRIP.
