The Army Materiel Command's LAO program has logistics assistance representatives (LARs) all over the world whose jobs are to solve your maintenance and supply problems.


If LARs don't have the answers handy, they know where to get them. They have contacts with equipment managers, engineers, depot repair specialists and pubs folks.

If you don't know where your LAO is, check out DA Pam 750-8, *TAMMS*, Table C-2, beginning on Page 242.

You can also access LAO offices on the Internet. Go to <https://aeps.ria.army.mil/aepspublic.cfm> and click on AMC LAO OFFICES under Public Applications. That takes you to a locator webpage displaying LAO regions on a flattened globe. Click on the region you want and you'll get a map of the region and where LAOs are located.

Click on the location you want and you'll get the email address for that office.
