



Y'HEAR THAT?


THAT'S THE FAINT SOUND HEARD HERE AND THERE AROUND THE MOTOR POOL.

IT'S THE SOUND OF OIL LEAKING FROM VEHICLES.

OR IT COULD BE LEAKING FUEL, LUBRICANT, ANTIFREEZE OR BRAKE FLUID.




WHATEVER'S DRIPPING, ONCE IT SEEPS INTO THE GROUND, IT'S CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS MATERIAL.



SO, UNTIL YOU GET THOSE LEAKS FIXED, PUT SOME DRIP PANS UNDER THEM!

HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS FOR USING DRIP PANS...

LOOK AT THE PANS EVERY DAY, BEFORE AND AFTER WORK. EMPTY THEM INTO APPROVED HAZMAT CONTAINERS OR DRUMS.



NEVER ALLOW PANS TO OVERFLOW. HAZMAT WILL RUN DOWN DRAINS AND EVENTUALLY POLLUTE GROUND WATER.

OVERFLOWING PANS ALSO CREATE CLEANUP HEADACHES. THAT MEANS MORE WORK, MORE PAPERWORK AND MORE COSTS FOR YOUR UNIT.

IF VEHICLES ARE LEFT OUTSIDE ON RAINY DAYS, CHECK THE DRIP PANS OFTEN. YOU DON'T WANT PANS FILLING WITH RAINWATER, OVERFLOWING AND SPREADING HAZMAT.

PLASTIC DRIP PANS CAN CRACK AND LEAK.

BUT RUBBER PANS WON'T CRACK, AND THEY'LL SNAP BACK IF THEY'RE CRUSHED.

GET RUBBER PANS WITH THESE NSNS...

THE FOLLOWING RUBBER PANS COME WITH A 6-FT CHAIN AND CLIP FOR ATTACHING THE PAN TO YOUR EQUIPMENT...

REPORT ANY OVERFLOWING PANS OR SPILLS AROUND THE MOTOR POOL TO YOUR UNIT'S HAZMAT OFFICER OR NCO. HE HAS THE EQUIPMENT AND KNOW-HOW TO GET RID OF HAZARDOUS WASTE SAFELY.

COMMON ITEMS LIKE DRY SWEEP AND RAGS BECOME SOAKED AND CONTAMINATED WITH FUEL, OIL, SOLVENTS AND THE LIKE. THEY, TOO, MUST BE HANDLED AS HAZARDOUS WASTE.

AS ALWAYS, IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, TALK WITH YOUR UNIT'S HAZMAT OFFICER OR NCO OR THE ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICE SUPPORTING YOUR UNIT OR INSTALLATION.

ONE OTHER THING: IT'S NOT JUST DRIP PANS AND THEIR CONTENTS YOU NEED TO WORRY ABOUT.
