

Hazardous Materials Information Resource System (HMIRS)

Looking for material safety data sheets (MSDS)? Then the Hazardous Materials Information Resource System (HMIRS) is the place for you. HMIRS is the Army's functional and transportation tool guide for all HAZMAT info.

HMIRS is the official DOD entry for complete product needs for hazardous material prevention and used by the DOD, ODA, and other federal agencies.

In addition to MSDS, HMIRS also provides transportation data - including proper shipping names, hazard classes, and shipping label requirements associated with HAZMAT transportation both domestically and internationally.

LOGSA's Packaging, Storage, Communication Center (P3C) is the Army's primary representative in development of updates to HMIRS. They review and propose changes to ensure system functionality. P3C also participates in beta and functional testing of the system before each version is released to users.

LOGSA assigns the Army vehicle registration numbers that are used to compile, track, and manage the Army's fleet. LOGSA publishes the MSDF twice a year in January and July in accordance with AR 700-136, Army Logistics: Acquisition and Inventory Management.
