


Get Smarter on Your Starter

WHEN IT'S TIME TO MOVE OUT, YOU WANT YOUR VEHICLE TO START.

BUT IN COLD WEATHER, ESPECIALLY, VEHICLES END UP IN A MAINTENANCE BAY WAITING FOR STARTERS TO BE REPLACED.

That's because all it takes is operating the starter too long to burn out a good starter motor. So **don't** engage the starter for more than 15 seconds! And give the starter at least one minute to cool off before trying to start it again.

No more than 3 tries and no more than 15 seconds per try!



IF YOUR TRUCK'S ENGINE WON'T START AFTER **THREE TRIES**, HAVE YOUR MECHANIC FIGURE OUT WHAT'S WRONG.
