WILL THE SOLDIER KNOW THE DIFFERENCE?


WELL, IN ONE CASE, A SOLDIER *DIDN'T* KNOW WHAT HIS BUDDIES WERE UP TO.

THE SOLDIER WAS RUSHED TO THE HOSPITAL, EXAMINED AND TREATED.


LUCKILY, HE DIDN'T SWALLOW ENOUGH TO INFLICT ANY HARM.
