




# A SPOTLIGHT ON... SPOTLIGHTS




CREWMEN, THE **LAST** THING YOU WANT TO HEAR IS A LOUD **POP!** WHEN YOU RAISE THE BOOM ON YOUR M88A1 RECOVERY VEHICLE.

WHY? BECAUSE THAT MEANS YOU **FORGOT** TO KEEP THE SPOTLIGHT ON TOP OF THE VEHICLE IN THE CORRECT POSITION.

The spotlight has a swivelling base. If you leave it turned toward the **outside** of the vehicle, the boom's stay line can hook it. Then, when the boom comes up, the spotlight gets ripped loose with a loud POP!

Spotlight turned to outside of vehicle gets hooked by stay line



Avoid that damage by keeping the spotlight turned toward the **inside** of the vehicle. That keeps it out of harm's way.

Keep spotlight turned inside to prevent damage
