HERE'S HOW TO TRACK IT DOWN...


1. Go to the DLA Troop Support website: <http://www.troopsupport.dla.mil/>
2. Once you get there, expand Supply Chains in the left-hand banner.
3. Click on Construction & Equip't.
4. On the next screen, expand Customer Information.
5. Click on Fastener Catalogs.
6. On the next screen, you'll find links to Fastener Catalog (on line), Fastener Assortments, and Nuts & Washers (5310) Catalogs.

- a fastener catalog of bolts, cap screws and machine screws, along with their composition, diameters, lengths, NIINs, NSNs or part numbers
- catalogs of self-locking nuts, flat washers and lock washers
- assortments of screws, bolts, nuts, washers and threaded rods—each with its own NSN

## Not Just Any Old Fasteners



THESE FASTENERS ARE HANDY FOR DO-IT-YOURSELF PROJECTS, SUCH AS REPAIRING A CAGE, BUILDING A WORKBENCH OR ADDING SHELVES IN A TOOL ROOM.

BUT NEVER USE THEM TO REPAIR OR REASSEMBLE EQUIPMENT WITHOUT FIRST CONSULTING THE TM.

USE ONLY THE EXACT FASTENERS CALLED FOR IN THE TM.

REMEMBER, BOLTS AND SCREWS ARE PRECISION MATERIALS. THE WRONG ONES COULD  $\approx$ SNAP $\approx$  UNDER STRESS!

YOU'RE CLOSE ENOUGH TO THE BOLT I NEED.

CLOSE ONLY COUNTS IN HORSESHOES AND HAND GRENADES, NOT WHEN YOU'RE DOING MAINTENANCE!

AND THAT COULD BE DANGEROUS, EVEN FATAL.

## Old Camo Still Serving

Do you have old lightweight camouflage screening systems (LCSS), their support systems or repair kits? Do you need replacement parts? Order them from the CECOM Life Cycle Management Command (LCMC). CECOM has some LCSS desert and woodland stock in Ownership/Condition Code AA. Once the LCSS stock is exhausted, CECOM will tell the field to order the replacement ultralightweight camouflage net systems (ULCANS).

At present, CECOM is not releasing the LCSS for snow because stocks are low. Appendix D of TM 5-1080-200-13&P lists part numbers and NSNs for the LCSS. Appendix C of TM 5-1080-250-12&P lists part numbers and NSNs for the ULCANS. You'll find the TMs online at the Electronic Technical Manuals website:
