


FORK EXTENSIONS ARE A NO-GO!

THAT'S WHY TACOM LCMC SPECIFICALLY **DOES NOT** AUTHORIZE THEM FOR THESE FORKLIFTS. THE FORKLIFT MANUFACTURER, JLG, ALSO RECOMMENDS AVOIDING THE EXTENSIONS.
