## Release of the New Enterprise Portal (UPDATED) Strategic Communications Document



The United States Army Materiel Command (AMC) Logistics Support Activity (LOGSA) and Project Manager Army Enterprise Systems Integration Program (PM AESIP) announce the release of the new Enterprise Portal going live 10 December 2018.

The new Enterprise Portal creates a single point of entry to access the current Logistics Information Warehouse (LIW) and AESIP Hub capabilities. This portal delivers a seamless integration of data, empowering analytics and Business Intelligence (BI) reporting across the multitude of disparate enterprise and enterprise-enabling logistics systems.

During this rollout, current LIW and AESIP Hub users will be grandfathered access to the new Enterprise Portal and will have uninterrupted access to the capabilities with which they are familiar, as well as any emerging enterprise capabilities via the Enterprise Portal. This portal hosts logistics data, financial data related to supply and maintenance, BI and analytical tools, and the converged capabilities of LIW and AESIP while continuing to provide access to BI tools such as the Lead Materiel Integrator Decision Support Tool (LMI DST), the Army Readiness Common Operating Picture (AR-COP), and many of the other tools currently accessible through the LIW Portal and AESIP Hub. **Note that the LIW Portal is scheduled for sunset (i.e., retired) on 21 December 2018.**

To facilitate a seamless transition to the Enterprise Portal, LOGSA and PM AESIP collaborated on the development of a streamlined process for requesting accounts and roles to access enterprise capabilities and functionality. The Identification Management (IdM) solution supporting the new Enterprise Portal has undergone rigorous integration testing and evaluation by stakeholders. As part of a phased approach, each subsequent release will introduce additional capabilities and functionality to associated roles across the Army and its trading partners.

**To enable the implementation of this new IdM solution, all System Authorization Access Requests (SAAR) submitted via the LIW Portal that have not been fully approved prior to 7 December 2018 will require resubmission through the new Enterprise Portal IdM solution to be released on 10 December 2018.**

**AESIP Hub users will no longer use the Department of Defense Form 2875 "SAAR" to request access. Beginning 10 December 2018, access requests will utilize the eSAAR procedure.**

On 10 December 2018, eSAAR training using the new IdM solution will be available through end-user training on the AESIP Training Portal at: <https://uperform.armyerp.army.mil/>.

This training covers each of the following audiences:

- Individuals requesting roles for current and new users
- Approvers including Supervisors, Personal Security Managers, Functional Security Officers, and Role Owners
- Provisioning Administrators
- Administrative Suite Users
